With three state parks in our county and our lake being a reservoir to TVA, there are plenty of options to find a trail and spend a day hiking and exploring our area.

TVA houses the Guntersville Dam, and they have created some hiking trails all around the dam along with some great spots to picnic.

Bucks Pocket State Park will take your breath away with stunning views that let you see three states: Alabama, Tennessee and Georgia.

Cathedral Caverns State Park shows stunning views of underneath the earth, but if you want a little more after your tour hike one of their easy and quick trails.

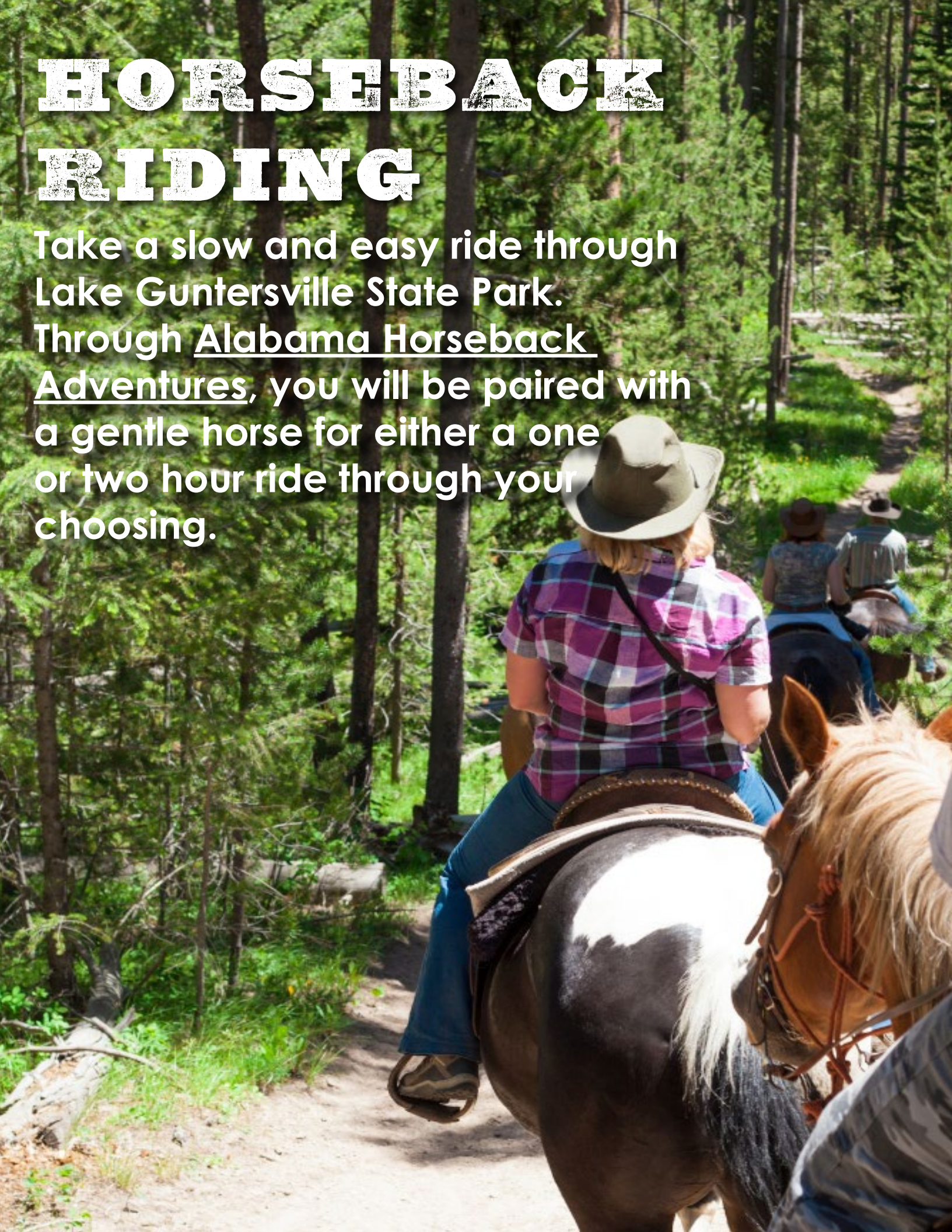
Lake Guntersville State Park houses
